

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 the regulation (EC) N° 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of Council concerning the registration, evaluation, authorisation and restriction of chemical substances (REACH) went into effect.

**Auramarine Ltd.** and **Auramarine Asia Ltd.** aim to ensure a high level of protection of human health and the environment.

**Auramarine Ltd.** and **Auramarine Asia Ltd.** are supplying only non-chemical products (articles) as defined in REACH (Article 3 Definitions). These articles and their packaging materials do not contain any substances which are intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use. Therefore a registration according Article 7 (1) with the European Agency for Chemicals (ECHA) does not apply.


On part of our suppliers there is no restriction for the ability to deliver.

Furthermore in our products there currently are no substances specified in the candidate list of substances of very high concern (Art. 59(10), January 15<sup>th</sup> 2018, 181 substances) as from a content of more than 0.1%. For that, **Auramarine Ltd.** and **Auramarine Asia Ltd.** are neither obligatory for registration nor for the creation of material safety data sheets.
